	Asparagus
Starting position	: couples, M on L side, in a big circle, face C, hold hands, arms in V position

- A1: W 4 steps fwrd to C, 4 steps back M 4 steps fwrd to C, turn ½ right, 4 steps fwrd to face pt
- A2: gipsy with pt 1&1/2 allemande L with L corner
- B1: balance & swing with pt
- B2: M roll back to their L & promenade with new pt

End with this new pt, open up to the C

*Gipsy*: two dancers move clockwise around each other while maintaining eye contact, upper body bent and turned toward the other dancer

*Corner*: the person who is beside you, the opposite sex, who is not your partner

Roll back: M leave his W, turn left next the W who is close behind
